Why Raise money for Coed Phoenix Nature Reserve?

When the woodland was first purchased and the 'not for profit organisation' Green Phoenix was set-up, the site supported very little wildlife. Non native trees covered 99% of the site and they were rapidly shading out all other life. More than 250 volunteers have helped to transform the site into an amazing wildlife reserve. More than 3000 native broadleaf trees have now been planted including thousands of feet of hedges.



A variety of additional habitat areas are being created, restored and maintained, including south facing banks, standing water, reptile hibernation sites, glades, dead wood piles, areas of coppiced woodland and bird and bat boxes.

Grassland, wet heath and areas of scrub have also been created or restored and these will be extended over the coming years. The majority of wildlife now found at Coed Phoenix would not be here if the site had not been managed specifically as a nature reserve.

We are delighted to have water voles breeding on site, visits from otters & dormice, more than a dozen species of dragon and damselflies and close to 60 species of birds recorded here.



Sites like Coed Phoenix are few and far between and are vital to the survival of much of our important wildlife. Coed Phoenix remains a work in progress and over the coming years we hope to improve further what we started ten years ago and we would like to continue to offer volunteers a safe place to learn crucial skills about land management and wildlife. Providing meals and refreshments has been something that we have found to be very important over the years and we really hope to be able to carry on offering this to a wide range of groups and individuals.



Supporting this project offers the opportunity to reunite humans with wildlife and wild spaces and to protect species that are scarce or under threat. If we don't protect these habitats and our wildlife we damage our own health and well-being and more seriously the health and well-being of future generations.
